## Before 13<sup>th</sup> Session of the Universal Periodic Review UPR on Algeria

#### Geneva, 29 May 2012

### Madam President,

The Islamic Republic of Iran warmly welcomes the delegation of Algeria led by the distinguished Minister of Foreign Affairs, H.E Mr. Mourad Medelci, and highly appreciates them for their presentation as well as their comprehensive national report.
