

# Statement by the Islamic Republic of Iran 13th Session of the UPR Working Group

#### On Indonesia

### 23 May 2012

#### Madam President,

The Islamic Republic of Iran would like to welcome the delegation of Indonesia and thank them for their informative statement and also for presenting a well prepared and comprehensive national report.

My delegation would also like to thank Indonesia for the positive developments made in several legislative, normative and institutional frameworks such as human rights education and training for the promotion and protection of human rights in the period of 2008–2012.

Moreover, we acknowledge the role of Indonesia in actively supporting various efforts in sharing best practices in the promotion and protection of human rights at the regional and multilateral level.

## Madam President,

We would like to make the following recommendations to Indonesia:

- To Continue its efforts on capacity-building programs of law enforcement officials in strengthening the implementation of existing laws, policies and measures relating to human rights,
- To continue promoting the human rights education and training at all educational levels,
- To accelerate the free twelve year compulsory education to ensure access to education for all Indonesian children,
- To take diplomatic action and provides legal assistance to protect migrant workers and to develop a comprehensive casehandling system for the problems of migrant workers, especially domestic workers,
- -To schedule discussion of the Draft Law on the Recognition and Protection of the Rights of Indigenous Peoples,
- As a follow-up to the ratification of CRPD, to develop moniforing on the vulnerability of women with disabilities to violence and the difficulties they face in accessing justice
  - To enhance women participation in politics, including by empowering women in decision-making machineries,
