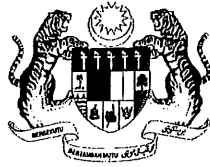

**Statement by Malaysia
Review of Indonesia
13th Session of the UPR Working Group of the Human Rights Council
21 May – 4 June 2012**

Thank you Madam President,

My delegation wishes to firstly extend a very warm welcome to the delegation of Indonesia, led by H.E. Dr. R.M. Marty M. Natalegawa to this session of the UPR Working Group. We thank the delegation for the comprehensive update on the situation of human rights in Indonesia particularly after the submission of Indonesian first UPR in 2008.

Madam President,

2. My delegation wishes to congratulate the Government of Indonesia on the progress achieved in many areas of promotion and protection of human rights in the country. The Government's serious effort and commitment is evident, among others, from the adoption of an extensive list of national human rights legislations and the launching of its Third National Plan of Action on Human Rights (2011-2014).

3. As a close neighbour of Indonesia, Malaysia appreciates Indonesia's contributions in the areas of capacity building, sharing of best practises as well as dialogues and other cooperation on human rights issues at the bilateral and regional including through its involvement in the ASEAN Intergovernmental Commission on Human Rights (AICHR) and ASEAN Commission on the promotion and protection the rights of Women and children (ACWC).

Madam President,

4. To further accelerate the progress in areas of promotion and protection of human rights, my delegation would like to propose the following recommendations for the consideration of Indonesia:

4.1 To intensify efforts on public awareness and capacity-building program of law enforcement officials in strengthening the implementation of existing law, policies and measures relating to human rights; and

4.2 To further enhance the partnership with relevant NHRIs and civil society to better coordination in planning and implementation of national human activities and programmes among all stakeholders.
