

Statement by H.E. Maung Wai

Permanent Representative of Myanmar to the United Nations
on the National Report of Indonesia under the UPR
at the Interactive Dialogue of the 13th Session of UPR Working Group
23 May 2012

Madame President,

My Delegation commends the significant progress that Indonesia has achieved in the promotion and protection of human rights, in particular its impressive achievement in uplifting the well-being of its people.
