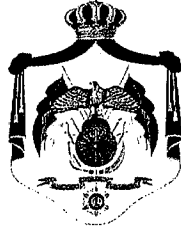

Madam President,

Jordan would like to welcome Mr. *Henry Jose Herrera* and the Peruvian delegation to the fourteenth session of the UPR, and to thank them for the interesting presentation of the national report.

Jordan wishes to commend Peru for its sincere and ongoing efforts to further promote and protect human rights and fundamental freedoms. We are particularly encouraged by the adoption of the Peruvian government of a series of measures to eradicate child labour, noteworthy among them is the establishment of the National Steering Committee on the Prevention and Eradication of Child Labour (CPETI).

In addition, Peru's efforts to strengthen the institutional framework are highly appreciated. These efforts included for Example, adopting a legislation which defines the competencies of the Ministry of Justice, as the main authority in the area of human rights. Also the adoption of a National Policy Plan on Older Persons. Jordan commends Peru for its National Programme to Combat Domestic and Sexual Violence which aims at drawing up and carrying out nationwide measures and policies to provide care, protection and support to victims of domestic and sexual violence. We hope that Peru will continue to render its support to these

bodies so that they can discharge their mandates in the most effective manner.

Finally, we wish to make the following recommendations to Peru:-

1. To complete its review of the Code on Children and Adolescents to draw up legislation to prohibit corporal punishment and humiliating treatment of children and adolescents;
2. To continue developing the institutional framework with respect to the promotion and protection of human rights.
