## INTERVETION OF THE REPUBLIC OF ANGOLA ON THE OCCASION OF UNIVERSAL PERIODIC REVIEW OF HUMAN RIGHTS OF THE REPUBLIC OF SRI LANKA

Madame President,

Allow me to welcome the delegation of the Republic of Sri and thank for the report.

The Republic of Angola notes the enormous challenges facing Sri Lanka as post conflict country in several areas, including in the capacity building of human rights promotion and protection.

Angola commends the decision made by the Sri Lanka government to put forward a plan of action for the implementation of the recommendations formulated by the Commission of education and national reconciliation contained on its report of December 2011.

Angola welcomes the commitment of the Government of Sri Lanka which led to the establishment of a working group to monitor the implementation of report recommendations. We believe that those measures contribute to strengthening the promotion and the protection of human rights.

Angola would like to offer two recommendations:

- 1. Strength the cooperation with the relevant human rights stakeholders including the Human Rights Council.
- 2. Continue the efforts to strengthening the capacity building of national institutions in field of human rights promotion and protection.
