Uganda commends the Government of Zambia for updating us on the developments that have taken place since the last review especially programmes for the advancement of women under the Ministry of Gender and Child Development.

The extensive legal and policy reforms undertaken in response to the UPR recommendations and Zambia's commitment to its obligations as a Member of the International Community are noteworthy.

Uganda further commends the efforts of the Government of Zambia in Intentification, the fight against HIV/AIDS especially in promoting prevention, identity the attention, and expanding and integrating prevention in all aspects of care at all healthcare centres.

Finally, Uganda recommends that Zambia takes more steps in the fight against HIV/ADS by carrying out sensitization programmes and also learning from the best practices available in this area.
