## **Barbados**

## Question

In 2008, Barbados agreed to address discrimination against women, and take steps to enact legislation to enshrine a specific right of non-discrimination on the basis of sex. Can the delegation from Barbados provide an update on the implementation of these recommendations?

## Recommendations

Canada recommends that Barbados:

- 1. Establish a mechanism for collecting and evaluating data on incidents of domestic violence and sexual harassment so as to assist the Government in tackling violence against women.
- 2. Repeal laws that criminalize consensual same sex adult sexual relations.

## **Observations**

The government's National Disabilities Unit is to be commended with respect to its numerous programs for persons with disabilities, including Call-a-Ride and Dial-a-Ride public transportation programs, sensitization workshops for public transportation operators, inspections of public transportation vehicles, sign language education programs, integrated summer camps, and accessibility programs.
