

STATEMENT OF VIET NAM

at the 15th session of the HRC WG on UPR of Barbados (Geneva, 25 January 2013)

Mr. President,

Viet Nam warmly welcomes and thanks the delegation of Barbados led by
for the presentation of the UPR national report this morning. We commend Barbados' seriousness in preparing her second UPR report as an illustration of her commitment to the promotion and protection of all human rights.
