

**Statement by the  
Islamic Republic of Iran  
UPR report of Luxembourg  
15<sup>th</sup> Session the Human Rights Council  
24 January 2013**

**Mr. President,**

My delegation has taken note of the national report as well as the introductory statement delivered by the distinguished delegation of Luxembourg.

We would like to draw the attention of the Working Group to the compilation reports of treaty bodies, special procedures, and the Office of the High Commissioner which have raised, among others, concerns on the violation of human rights by the government of Luxembourg, particularly on its racist and xenophobic acts as well as increasing child prostitution and child pornography.

**Mr. President,**

While sharing the said concerns, my delegation would like to make the following recommendations to Luxembourg:

- 1- Take legal measures in order to combat racist, xenophobic and Islamophobic acts and their manifestations.

- 2- Take necessary steps to provide basic rights for migrants and asylum seekers.
- 3- Take necessary measures to hand in its national reports to the Committee on the Elimination of Racial Discrimination on time.
- 4- Take effective measures to implement the National Plan of Action (NPA) adopted in 1996, to combat and prevent Child Prostitution, Child Pornography and also trafficking of children for commercial sexual exploitation.
- 5- Implement the national action plan for persons with disabilities.
