Universal Periodic Review 15 – Luxemburg

Intervention by Montenegro

Mister President,

Montenegro warmly welcomes the delegation of Luxemburg and would like to thank for the comprehensive national report and the introductory statement by H.E.... Montenegro was pleased to hear about the progress of the implementation of the recommendations made during the last UPR Review, for example the recommendations concerning the prevention and elimination of all forms of violence against women.

Montenegro also noted, with satisfaction, that Luxemburg had taken a series of measures, through educational reform, allowing for differentiated teaching and the introduction of a skills based education. In addition, Montenegro welcomes the preparation of a national action plan for persons with disabilities.

Montenegro would like to recommend that Luxemburg:

- Intensify efforts to improve detention conditions, including the care of children and young people deprived of their liberty, that fully meet international human rights standards,
- Take all necessary steps to accelerate the enforcement of the law regarding the acceptance and integration of foreigners, and
- To further strengthen measures to grant foreign children and children of asylum-seekers equal access to the same standards of services in the field of education.
