

Statement by Her Excellency Ambassador <u>Graça Andresen Guimarães</u> Permanent Representative of Portugal

15th session of the Universal Periodic Review Working Group Mali

Mister President,

Allow me to start by expressing our deep condemnation for the attacks from terrorist movements based in the North that are jeopardizing the country's territorial integrity and safety of its population.

Portugal calls on all parties to respect international humanitarian law and human rights. It is our firm belief that all those responsible for human rights violations and abuses must be held accountable for their acts.

Mr President,

We hope that peace and stability will be speedily restored in Mali. We also hope that further efforts will be made by the Malian authorities to address the challenges faced in the field of human rights.

In this regard, Portugal would like to formulate the following recommendations:

- 1. That legislation is urgently adopted to ban Female Genital Mutilation.
- 2. That the Malian Parliament speeds up its internal procedures towards the approval of the draft bill to abolish the death penalty;
- 3. That Mali issues a standing invitation to all special procedures of the Human Rights Council;
- 4. Lastly, that Mali ratifies the Optional Protocol of the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights
