## **REVIEW OF ROMANIA**

## MR. PRESIDENT,

- 1. Cambodia warmly welcomes the delegation of Romania led by H.E. Mr. Bogdan AURESCU, State Secretary, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, for his presentation and updating the Council on the follow up developments in the area of promotion and protection of Human Rights within the UPR process since the First Cycle.
- 2. Cambodia takes note with appreciation the commitments the Government of Romania has demonstrated in implementing the recommendations that had been put forward by the delegations of Members States and Stakeholders.
- 3. Cambodia warmly welcomes the progress made by the Government of Romania in the fields of protection and promotion of human rights, along with the further efforts of implementation of the justice reform. We also appreciate the ratification by Romania of the Optional Protocol to the Convention against Torture (OP/CAT) and the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities, among others.
