



## STATEMENT OF VIET NAM

Mr. President,

Viet Nam warmly welcomes and commends the Delegation of the Republic of Serbia led by His Excellency for its detailed presentation this afternoon, reflecting its seriousness in preparing the second UPR.

Serbia has made concretes steps over the last 4 years in protecting and promoting human rights at all level. Viet Nam is pleased to note the continued consolidation in Serbia's legislation and national infrastructure on human rights, including the adoption of numerous laws, national strategies and action plans on gender equality, women's empowerment, child care, migration, social integration for disable people, housing, education as well as refugee and internal displaced persons.

Viet Nam also commends Serbia's efforts in combating racial discrimination, racism and particularly in ensuring the respect to and the full enjoyment of human rights and human dignity of minority people in the country.
