**Statement of the delegation of the Kyrgyz Republic
during the interactive dialogue of the UPR Working Group
on Cameroon
1 May, 2013**

Mr. President,

Kyrgyzstan welcomes the delegation of Cameroon and commends Cameroon for the concrete progress achieved since the last review. Cameroon has continued and intensified its cooperation with OHCHR, Treaty Bodies and Special Procedures.

My delegation is pleased to note that Cameroon, in collaboration with its partners, has initiated the National Action Plan adoption process for human rights promotion and protection, aiming at integrating the human rights approach in policies and programme.

We welcome the implementation of the Integrated Management of Childhood Illnesses strategy (IMCI), with the aim of reducing mortality due to common childhood diseases, including acute respiratory infections, diarrheal diseases, malaria and malnutrition. Since 2005 Cameroon has taken measures to prevent, treat and care for persons living with HIV.

However, more measures need to be taken in terms of planning and budgeting in view of the inadequacies in allocation and distribution of public funding. We recommend that Cameroon implements the 2011–2015 Health Sector Strategy. Also, my delegation recommends Cameroon to ensure women's access to reproductive health services.

In conclusion, my delegation wishes success to the Cameroon's authorities in the promotion and protection of human rights.
