Mister President, the Philippines thanks the delegation of Cameroon led by HE Mr. PIERRE MOWORD MEONID, MINISTER FOR APRIC for the presentation of its national report to the 16th Session of the UPR Working Group. The Philippines commends Cameroon for striving to meet its accepted UPR recommendations despite the financial and other constraints it faces in pursuit of the full realization of the human rights of its people.
