We consider that apart these elements there are issues of concern such as the restrictions on freedom of association, freedom of speech, allegations of torture in the detention places and the execution of judgments of the European Court of Human Rights.</p> <p>We hope that Russian Federation will continue to pay attention to these issues as well as to the ratification of international instruments on human rights not yet ratified.</p> <p>We therefore recommend Russia to ratify the Second Optional Protocol to the International Covenant of Civil and Political Rights aiming at the abolition to the death penalty and the Rome Statute establishing the International Criminal Court.</p> <p>We also recommend Russia to remove any restriction on the freedom of association incompatible with its obligations under international law.</p>
