Statement by the Delegation of Nepal, at an interactive dialogue with the delegation of the People's Republic of China during the 17<sup>th</sup> session of the Working Group on the Universal Periodic Review, 22 October 2013

Mr. President

Nepal welcomes the delegation of the People's Republic of China led by H. E. Mu.: Who Mailong. Special Envoy of the Ministry of Francism Africa. J. Chimand congratulates for the comprehensive presentation of the national report that highlights the developments since the first review.
