## Mr. President

Uganda wishes to single out the following exemplarity measures and interventions taken by the Congolese Government.

- 1. Participatory and inclusive national process in compiling, drafting and approval of the report.
- 2. Strategy to combat poverty and strengthen economic growth and service delivery especially vulnerable groups.
- 3. Consolidation of peace and democracy right from the grassroots.
- 4. Elaboration of a comprehensive agenda to improve health sectors especially to fight the scourge of HIV/AIDS, maternal mortality and child mortality.
- 5. Provision of free scholastic and education materials up to secondary school level.
- 6. Joint action plan to with Benin to combat child trafficking.

We recommend that the Government of Congo

- 1. Continues to ratify relevant International Conventions
- 2. Continues its efforts to combat all forms of discrimination.
- 3. Ensures the protection of and respect for persons with disabilities.
