

STATEMENT OF VIET NAM By Dr. Pham Quoc Tru, Minister, Deputy Permanent Representative

During the 2nd UPR of the Kingdom of Jordan at the 17th session of the UPR working Group of the Human Rights Council (9:00-12:00, Friday, October 24, 2013)

Mr. President,

My delegation would like to welcome and thank the delegation of Jordan for her second UPR report presented to the Council this morning.

We take note of Jordan's efforts made in the socio-economic development and the improvement of legislation system and national mechanisms for better human rights promotion and protection in Jordan.
