Statement by Pakistan for the UPR of Malaysia 17th Session of the UPR Working Group 24 October 2013

Madam Vice President,

My delegation warmly welcomes H.E. Ms. Dato' Ho May Yong for presentation of a balanced and objective second national report.

We highly appreciate the constructive engagement of the Malaysian Government with the review mechanism through implementation of majority of the recommendations received during its first cycle of the UPR.
