Statement by the Delegation of the Republic of Uzbekistan

Mr. President,

Uzbekistan welcomes the delegation of Malaysia to the second cycle of the UPR and thanks for the presentation of its national report.

The Report provides comprehensive information on human rights situation in Malaysia. It indicates clearly actual goals and objectives in the field of human rights and specific actions to be taken in order to achieve them.

We note with satisfaction the significant progress made in Malaysia in promoting and protecting human rights and freedoms since the first review of the country in 2009.

We welcome Malaysia's accession to the two Optional Protocols to the Convention on the Rights of the Child and the country's intention to accede to the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights.
