Statement by the Delegation of Nepal, at an interactive dialogue with the delegation of the Republic of Mauritius during the 17th session of the Working Group on the Universal Periodic Review, 23 October 2013

Mr. President

Nepal welcomes the delegation of the Republic of Mauritius led by H. E. Dr. Arvin Boolell, Minister of Foreign Affairs, Regional Integration and International Trade of the Republic of Mauritius, and congratulates for the comprehensive presentation of the national report.
