(9:00-12:30, Tuesday, January 28, 2014)

Mr. President,

My Vietnamese delegation warmly welcomes the delegation of Chile and thanks H.E Minister Bruno Baranda for the detailed presentation of the country's comprehensive report.

Viet Nam notes with interest for Chile's encouraging human rights achievements for her people, such as the ratification of most core human rights treaties, the adoptions of the Anti-discrimination Act and establishment of the National Human Rights Institute.

In the Council, Viet Nam commends Chile for her active roles and contributions during the current term.

Mr. President,

Taking this opportunity, and in views of challenges facing Chile, Viet Nam wishes to make two recommendations:

1. Strengthen the state of laws and good governance, including further capacity building for laws enforcement mechanisms and national institutions on human rights.
2. Continue current national strategies and programmes for enhancing employment opportunities, social welfare, education and health care system, especially for families in rural areas, migrants, indigenous and tribal people in Chile.

Viet Nam is ready to cooperate with Chile and wishes Chile every success in her second UPR cycle.
