

## STATEMENT BY BRUNEI DARUSSALAM DURING THE REVIEW OF VIET NAM AT THE 18<sup>TH</sup> SESSION OF THE WORKING GROUP OF THE UNIVERSAL PERIODIC REVIEW

## 5 FEBRUARY 2014 PALAIS DES NATIONS, GENEVA

Thank you, Mr. President.
