STATEMENT BY MALAYSIA Review of Viet Nam 18th Session of the UPR Working Group of the Human Rights Council 27 January – 7 February 2014

Thank you Mr. President,

Malaysia warmly welcomes H.E. Mr. Ha kim Ngor and his delegation to the 18th Session of the UPR Working Group and thank them for the presentation of their national report.

- 2. Malaysia commends the progress made by Viet Nam in the promotion and protection of human rights since its first UPR review.
