Albania welcomes the distinguished delegation of Brunei Darussalam for their comprehensive national report and its presentation today.

Albania commends the ongoing efforts to promote and protect human rights through the different consultative mechanisms, in cooperation with civil society and the progress for the achievements of Millennium Development Goals.

We welcome domestic legislation enforced or adopted on the rights of women and children, family, employment, education in order to ensure the continued promotion and protection of human rights in the country.

Also we commend the implementation of the plan of Action on Family Institution and Women which covers also children issues, the establishment of the Temporary Foster Scheme for children in need, and the organisation of awareness activities, education campaigns on the rights of the child.

We would like to make the following recommendations:

- To review its national legislation in conformity with the Convention on the Rights of the Child and the Convention on the Elimination of all Forms of Discrimination against Women.
- To take further measures to ensure sufficient data on the prevalence of the worst forms of child labour in the country and, particularly with regard to child trafficking.
- To implement awareness projects and activities to combat discriminatory attitudes, and further its efforts to promote human rights education.
