



STATEMENT OF VIET NAM By H.E. Mr. THANH T. NGUYEN, Ambassador, Permanent Representative

At the Review of the 2nd cycle UPR Report of Costa Rica

(Monday, May 5, 2014)

Mr. President,

Viet Nam welcomes Costa Rica to the 2nd cycle of UPR. We commend Costa Rica's endeavors in protecting and promoting human rights, especially the achievements in ensuring the rights of vulnerable groups, poverty alleviation and improvement of social services.
