Indonesia warmly welcomes Ethiopia's ratification of the CRPD in 2010 and notes that the ratification of the ICRMW is also currently underway. My delegation views that the ratification of core instruments of human right will help to strengthen the human rights framework in Ethiopia. Indonesia therefore recommends the Government of Ethiopia to continue its process towards the ratification of the ICRMW and to consider the ratification of CAT.

Indonesia is of the view that addressing the right of education is fundamental Indonesia applauds the high priority given by the government of Ethiopia to the field of education, including the provision of free primary education and the allocation of increasing resources to this sector. Indonesia recommends the Government of Ethiopia to ensure continuous progress in this priority area, including the inclusion of human rights education in its curriculum.
