## INTERVENTION BY INDIA

## Mr. President.

India welcomes the delegation of Nicaragua at its second Universal Periodic Review and thanks it for its National report and presentation.

We commend the action taken by Nicaragua in implementing the recommendations of its first UPR cycle and the steps taken to further strengthen the legislative and institutional framework for the protection and promotion of Human Rights in Nicaragua.

We take positive note of the work done by the office of the Human Rights Advocate in advancing basic human rights in Nicaragua. **We recommend** that Nicaragua continues to strengthen measures to ensure independence of the Office of the Human Rights Advocate.
