Statement by the Delegation of the Sudan

Review of Angola

Thursday, 30th October 2014

Mr. President,

The Delegation of the Sudan welcomes the delegation of **Angola** headed by H. E. the Minister of Justice and Human Rights and thanks the esteemed delegation for the informative and comprehensive presentation of the national report.

The commitment and positive engagement of **Angola** to the UPR process is commendable, and the information provided in the national report regarding the implementation of the recommendations presented to Angola in the first cycle, is encouraging. In particular, the ratification of the United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities and its optional protocol and the United Nations Convention on Organised Transnational Crime, and its additional protocols.

Sudan would like to recommend to the Government of Angola, the following:

1. To continue implementing the Integrated Programme of Rural Development and the Fight against Poverty.
2. To exert more efforts in setting up a National Human Rights Institution as an essential partner of the Government for questions relating to the promotion and protection of human rights.
