Recommendations made by Iceland to Bosnia and Herzegovina 20th session of the Universal Periodic Review

Mr President,

Iceland welcomes the honourable delegation of Bosnia and Herzegovina to the UPR.

My delegation echoes concerns raised by CERD about the persistence of racial and ethnic-based discrimination in Bosnia and Herzegovina and about public manifestation of hate speech. We recommend the establishment and strengthening of programmes for combatting prejudice and of mechanisms for monitoring acts of ethnic-based discrimination and violence.

While recognizing efforts to improve the situation of women in post-conflict situations, Iceland is concerned about the slow pace of prosecutions and low level of conviction rates of perpetrators of sexual violence. We recommend that Bosnia and Herzegovina expedite the adoption of laws and programmes designed to ensure effective access to justice for all victims of wartime sexual violence, including adequate reparation.

Iceland encourages Bosnia and Herzegovina to continue strengthening efforts to combat trafficking in human beings. We recommend that the effective implementation of existing legislation be ensured, including the provision of protection and assistance to victims and the timely prosecution and punishment of traffickers.
