

## STATEMENT OF VIET NAM

At the Review of the 2<sup>nd</sup> cycle UPR Report of Iraq
(Monday, 3<sup>rd</sup> November, 2014)

Mr. President,

Viet Nam welcomes Iraq to the 2<sup>nd</sup> cycle of UPR. We take note of the Iraq's efforts made in the protection and promotion of human rights in the country, especially those made in the enactment of new laws, the establishment of the national human rights plan, the promotion of the rights of priority groups and the prevention of human rights violation particularly by extremist groups.

Firm commitments and recent steps taken by the Government of Iraq in tackling terrorism, in addressing all forms of violence, and in providing adequate housing, food, education, are outstanding.
