Statement by the Delegation of Kazakhstan at the 20th Session of WG of HRC / UPR of Iraq

Kazakhstan's delegation welcomes the delegation of Iraq headed by H.E.

We thank His Excellency for a comprehensive presentation. Our delegation commends achievements and efforts of the Government of Iraq in protecting and promoting human rights and fundamental freedoms of its citizens.
