## Human Rights Council 20<sup>th</sup> session of the UPR Working Group Review of San Marino October 29, 2014 Intervention by Ukraine



## Mr. President,

Ukraine welcomes the delegation of San Marino and thanks for presentation of the national report reflecting efforts taken by the Government of San Marino to implement recommendations accepted during the first cycle of the Universal Periodic Review.

We commend San Marino's adherence to the UPR process and note with appreciation ratification since last review of a number of important international human rights mechanisms as well as adjustment of domestic legislation to relevant international norms.

Ukraine appreciates the progress made by San Marino in promotion and protection of human rights of its citizens, in particular, protection of the rights of women and ensuring gender equality.
