Statement of the Islamic Republic of Iran
Before the 20th Session of the UPR Working Group
On Review of Slovenia

Geneva, 4 November 2014

Mr. President,

My delegation welcomes the distinguished delegation of Slovenia and thanks them for their presentation today.

We welcome signs and ratified some international treaties by Slovenia Since 2010. We also welcome numerous regulations were adopted in an effort to codify health care by the government and the amended Health Services Act, which enhanced public health activities, guaranteeing high quality public health service with the available funds as well Health Insurance Act.

Mr. President,

We would like to draw the attention of this august Working Group to the compilation report of the Office of the High Commissioner which has risen, among others, few concerns on the violation of human rights by the government of

Slovenia particularly on violence against women and domestic violence and a growing number of violent against Roma people.

While, sharing with these concerns, my delegation would like to make the following recommendations to Slovenia:

1- To increase its efforts to combat against Racial Discrimination racist attacks, particularly against the Roma

2- Take necessary measures for setting up a comprehensive national strategy to prevent and address all forms of violence against women and children.

3- Take legal measures aimed at preventing ethnically motivated crimes

4- To ratify ICRMW.
