Intervention of Bangladesh on UPR of Guinea

Thank you Mr. President.

Bangladesh delegation welcomes the delegation of Guinea. We thank the delegation for the presentation of the informative national report.

Mr. President, my delegation fully appreciates the challenges faced by Guinea being a developing country. We commend the Government's commitment to undertake ambitious and courageous reforms aimed at building a democratic society that respects human rights despite the particularly difficult economic climate and complex structural realities.
