**Statement at the Universal Periodic Review (UPR) of the Republic of Kenya, Palais  
des Nations, Geneva, 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2015**

Trinidad and Tobago welcomes the delegation of the Republic of Kenya on this second cycle of their Universal Periodic Review (UPR) and wishes to express appreciation for the delivery of their comprehensive report.

My delegation notes the efforts Kenya has made to improve the quality of life of its people. Its strides to bolster food security and agriculture, increase access to free tuition at primary and secondary levels and improve the quality of education through e-learning are certainly commendable and parallel goals of our very own.

Trinidad and Tobago wishes to recommend that Kenya consider the following:

1. That measures be taken to increase the access of low-income children to education.
2. That steps be taken to increase opportunities to access higher education.
3. That efforts be increased to address the sexual exploitation of women and girls.
