Mr. President,

Serbia wishes a warm welcome to the delegation of Kuwait and thanks them for their comprehensive report.

We note with satisfaction the progress in promoting social and economic rights and in particular the adoption of the 2010 Labor Code, which strengthens employee's rights so as to prohibit dismissal on the grounds of gender as well as establishes a minimum age of employment.

We encourage Kuwait to continue promoting economic, social and cultural rights, and especially rights of women, children and persons with disabilities, as well as to enhance measures in combating discrimination.

We offer to Kuwait the following recommendations:

- 1) Continue to safeguard the principle of equality between men and women in financial, educational, healthcare and housing sectors by elaborating a comprehensive anti-discrimination law;
- 2) Proceed to adopt a National work plan for children's rights in the juvenile justice system.
