Thailand welcomes the delegation of Kuwait and thanks them for their presentation made of the report.

Thailand commends Kuwait's efforts, since its first review, in improving its normative framework and establishing national mechanisms to ensure the promotion and protection of human rights with particular interest toward vulnerable groups.
