**Statement by the Delegation of Indonesia  
The 21<sup>st</sup> Session of the Universal Periodic Review Working Group  
Consideration of the National Report of Kyrgyzstan  
Geneva, 19 January 2015**

Mr. President,

My delegation welcomes the delegation of Kyrgyzstan, led by H.E. Mr. Abdyrakhman Mamataliev, Vice Prime Minister of the Kyrgyzstan Republic, and thanks for the presentation of their national report.

The many advancements made by the government and people of Kyrgyzstan in the area of promotion and protection of human rights since the 2010 Revolution are commendable. Despite the profound changes to the social and political life of the country, the Government Kyrgyzstan's efforts in promoting and protecting human rights of its people has never faltered.

Mr. President,

Indonesia commends the special attention given by the Government of Kyrgyzstan to the issue of prevention of practices of torture. The adoption of a National Plan to Combat Torture as well as the establishment of the National Centre for the Prevention of Torture and other Cruel, Inhuman or Degrading Treatment or Punishment in 2012 are concrete manifestations of commitment of the Government of Kyrgyzstan after ratifying the Convention in 1997 and its Optional Protocol in 2008. Indonesia **recommends the Government of Kyrgyzstan to continue its effort in implementing the Convention against Torture and its Optional Protocol with more concrete actions.**

The high commitment of Kyrgyzstan to promote and protect human rights is also reflected in its preparation to ratify the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities. Indonesia notes with appreciation its efforts and **respectfully recommends the Government of Kyrgyzstan to accelerate its efforts to ratify the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities.**

In conclusion, Mr. President, my delegation would like to extend Indonesia's continuing support to the government and people of Kyrgyzstan in their efforts to promote and protect the human rights in the country.
