Recommendations to Turkey

In the framework of the Universal Periodic Review, 21st Session of the UPR Working Group (19-30 January, 2015)

Armenia would like to make the following recommendations to Turkey:

- 1. Fully implement the international obligations emanating from the UN Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of the Crime of Genocide.
- 2. Conduct effective investigation on the case of murder of Hrant Dink, Editor-in Chief of the Turkish language Armenian weekly "Agos"
- 3. Implement the policy of return of the confiscated properties to the Armenians and other religious minorities, such as places of worship, including monasteries, church properties and religious and cultural sites through close consultations with their legal owners.
- 4. Put an end to the unilateral economic coercive measures including blockade against Armenia, which violates human rights including social, economic and cultural rights.
- 5. Prevent use of its territory by foreign terrorist fighters who are engaged in massive human rights violations.
- 6. Ratify the Council of Europe Framework Convention for the Protection of National Minorities.
