Rwanda commends the progress Andorra has registered in promoting and protecting human rights of its people since its first review cycle. We particularly note with appreciation that Between September 2010 and December 2014, Andorra signed or ratified a further 15 instruments, including both optional and additional protocols to the conventions to which it was already party.

We further commend Andorra for adopting this year the Act on the Elimination of Gender-based and Domestic Violence which provides for the establishment of a National Commission for the Prevention of Gender-Based and Domestic Violence.

## Rwanda would like to make the following recommendations:

- Consider ratifying ILO Convention on Equal Remuneration
- Consider ratifying UNESCO Convention against Discrimination in Education.
