Mr. President,

The Delegation of the Sudan welcomes the distinguished delegation of **Belarus** and thanks the honourable head of the delegation H-E Deputy Minister for Foreign Affairs for the comprehensive presentation of the national report.

The commitment and positive engagement of **Belarus** to the UPR process is highly appreciated and the information provided in the national report regarding the implementation of the accepted 74 recommendations presented to **Belarus** during the first cycle in May 2010 is very encouraging.
