I warmly welcome the Delegation of the Republic of Croatia and thank the First Deputy Prime Minister for the presentation.

Georgia commends Croatia for addressing majority of recommendations accepted during the first UPR consideration.

We welcome the fact that in the reporting period Croatia ratified the Convention on the Reduction of Statelessness.

We commend Croatia for the efforts undertaken to strengthen human rights protection at national level.

I would like to ask the Delegation to provide information on how the correctional measures have been implemented towards juvenile criminal offenders.

We note steps conducted by Croatia in respect to the juvenile pretrial detention. Having said that, Georgia recommends that Croatian authorities continue to further improve the conditions for juveniles in pretrial detention facilities.
