Mr. President

Angola welcomes the delegation of Liberia and the presentation of a National report in this 22 Session.

Angola commends Liberia for the legislative and policy measures undertaken since its last periodic review, particularly for the protection of persons with disabilities, the protection of the right of the child as well as the fight against human trafficking.

We note with appreciation that in the scope of protection and promotion of human rights, the creation in 2013, of a National Human Rights Action Plan, the launching of the Strategic Roadmap for national healing, peacebuilding and reconciliation.

We commend Liberia for the successful developments undertaken in the justice system, which allows that more people get access to justice, as well as, the increase of regional structures in the scope of the justice and security sector, contributing for better conditions at prisons.

Angola recommends Liberia:

1. To strengthen support measures to vulnerable persons;
2. To fight the escalation of persons subjected to SGBV;
3. To fight genital mutilation and early-marriage;
4. To increase children access to the Education system.
