Review of the Republic of Liberia
Monday, 4 May 2015

Mr. President,

The Delegation of the Sudan welcomes the distinguished delegation of **Liberia** and thanks the honourable head of the delegation H-E Minister of Gender, Children and social protection for the comprehensive presentation and oral update.

Despite the challenges faced by **Liberia** in the recent year, Liberia has enjoyed a number of notable achievements such as the country conducted its second peaceful national presidential and legislative elections in 2011. We notice with Satisfaction that **Liberia** launched the National Human Rights Action Plan in December 2013 to improve implementation of its regional and international human rights obligations.
