STATEMENT BY THE CZECH REPUBLIC

The Czech Republic warmly welcomes the delegation of Libya. We thank the delegation for its informative presentation and appreciate Libya's response to some of our advance questions.

The Czech Republic has the following **recommendations** to the Government of Libya:

First, we **recommend** Libya to enact a plan to achieve national reconciliation based on dialogue and with the full ownership of all Libyans, including women and ethnic ~~and~~ religious minorities, while cooperating closely with the UN Support Mission in Libya (UNSMIL) and the OHCHR.

Second, we **recommend** that Libya ensure that all perpetrators of violations and abuses of the international human rights law and the international humanitarian law from all sides of the conflict are investigated, prosecuted and punished in accordance with international standards and cooperate with the International Criminal Court in this regard.

Finally, we **recommend** Libya to become a state party to the Convention relating to the Status of Refugees (1951) and its Protocol (1967).
