STATEMENT BY THE DELEGATION OF INDONESIA  
22<sup>ND</sup> SESSION OF THE UNIVERSAL PERIODIC REVIEW WORKING GROUP  
CONSIDERATION OF THE UPR REPORT OF THE LIBYAN ARAB REPUBLIC  
GENEVA, 13 MAY 2015

Mr. President,

My delegation would like to thank the delegation of the Libyan Arab Republic for the presentation of their national report.

Indonesia notes with appreciation of Libyan's efforts to further promote and protect human rights. We are confident that peace and reconciliation in the country can be built through bottom-up processes.

We note that Libya has strengthened its legal, institutional, and administrative measures including through, *inter alia*, enactment of laws on transitional justice, electoral law, and on disability.

In the spirit of dialogue and cooperation, my delegation wishes to submit the following recommendations:

1. **Enhance the capacity building programs for all branches of government.**
2. **Continue efforts to strengthen the role of the National Council for Civil Liberties and Human Rights (NCCLHR) in the promotion and protection of human rights in accordance to the Paris Principles.**

Finally, Indonesia would like to offer its best wishes to the Government and People of Libya in their future endeavours towards the promotion and protection of human rights at all levels.
