**UPR Working Group -22nd Session**  
**Statement of the Delegation of the Sudan**  
**Review of Malawi**  
**Tuesday, 5 May 2015**

**Mr. President,**

The Delegation of the Sudan welcomes the distinguished delegation of **Malawi** participating in this session and thanks the honourable for the comprehensive presentation and oral update.

My delegation appreciates the political developments since the last review in November 2010 in particular the holding of two peaceful political transition processes in April 2012 and in May 2014.

We commend the positive steps undertaken by Malawi for further protection and promotion of human rights in particular the adoption of the Disability Act in 2012 which provides for equalization of opportunities for persons with disabilities and the establishment of a Disability Trust Fund as well as the adoption of the National Action Plan to provide direction for progressive elimination of child labour from 2009 to 2016.

**Mr. President,**

Sudan would like to present to, **Malawi** the following recommendations:

1. To continue its efforts to raise public awareness of human rights in particular the child rights.
2. To continue strengthening the capacity of government institutions on human rights and to implement the strategies and plans especially on child labour.
3. To adopt Marriage, Divorce and Family Relations Bill.
